A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 27, 2015, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall report on additional expert reports on the width of the right of way before the next CMC on **June 30, 2015**.

[2] The Common Book of Documents shall contain all documents pertaining to this claim and to *Skuppah Indian Band v. HMQ*, SCT-7004-13 (“Skuppah Claim”). The Claimant may file an additional compilation of documents pertaining to this claim. The Parties shall jointly report on the status of the Common Book of Documents before the next CMC on **June 30, 2015**.

[3] The Parties shall report on the status of the Agreed Statement of Facts before the next CMC on **June 30, 2015**.

[4] Subject to decisions made at the next CMC, the Respondent will provide Will-Asks by **August 17, 2015**.

[5] The hearing on validity in this claim and in the Skuppah Claim is tentatively scheduled for **October 12 to 23, 2015**. The hearing will be held in the communities of the Claimant and the Skuppah Indian Band.

[6] The next CMC will be held in person, jointly with the Skuppah Claim on Tuesday, **June 30, 2015**, in Vancouver.
