A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 9, 2014, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with a proposed Amended Declaration of Claim including assertions directly relating to the Crown's failure to return the lands at issue on or before **December 19, 2014.** 

[2] The Respondent shall advise whether it consents to the proposed Amended Declaration of

Claim on or before January 16, 2015.

[3] If the Respondent consents to the amendment, the Claimant shall file the Amended

Declaration of Claim and the Respondent shall have 30 days from the filing date of the Amended

Declaration of Claim to file its Amended Response. If the Respondent does not consent to the

amendment, the Tribunal shall establish a timeline for ruling on the issue at the next CMC.

[4] The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with a letter detailing the basis for the

Claimant's claim for injurious affection on or before January 30, 2015.

[5] The Respondent shall provide its response to the draft Agreed Statement of Facts

provided by the Claimant on or before January 30, 2015.

[6] It is expected that the Respondent will be in possession of the documents it requested

from the Province of British Columbia by mid-February 2015.

[7] The Parties shall file a Joint Status Report, if possible (otherwise separate reports), on

target dates for the completion of a Common Book of Documents, an Agreed Statement of Issues

and an Agreed Statement of Facts, and on the bifurcation issue on or before March 18, 2015.

[8] The next CMC shall be held by teleconference on March 23, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern

Time (Ottawa).
