A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 26, 2014, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported their progress with respect to production of documents, in particular by the Respondent. Substantial agreement has been reached but the Parties are still in discussion on the question of production of documents pertaining to general underlying federal policies of

the granting of the easement at the time in question. The Parties expressed optimism that they will reach an agreement but they require more time.

[2] The Claimant identified Mr. Harold Jones as the elder expected to provide oral history evidence. The Claimant is in the process of arranging to interview Mr. Jones and will then provide a Will-Say Statement of his anticipated evidence, after which the Respondent may deliver its Will-Ask Statement.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on September 22, 2014, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa) with a view to discussing the progress of the matters described above and determining the appropriate next steps.
