ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 2, 2017, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant had filed the historical expert report of Dr. Peggy Martin-McGuire with the Tribunal on May 8, 2015; and more recently, the Claimant filed the historical appraisal expert report of Norris Wilson with the Tribunal on April 3, 2017.

[2] The Respondent shall serve and file its responding expert reports prepared by Dr. Derek Whitehouse-Strong (in response to Dr. Martin-McGuire) and Mr. Hal Love (in response to Mr. Wilson) on or before **July 31, 2017**. The Claimant shall serve and file its reply expert reports (if any) on or before **September 15, 2017**.

[3] The Parties shall file a Common Book of Documents on or before **September 30, 2017**.

[4] If the Parties decide to produce an Agreed Statement of Facts, they shall make best efforts to file it with the Tribunal on or before **September 30, 2017**. The Parties shall provide jointly or separately a status report on the anticipated production of an Agreed Statement of Issues (and Agreed Statement of Facts if necessary) on or before **October 17, 2017**.

[5] The expert evidence hearing will be held on **January 8 to 12, 2018**, in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. A pre-hearing conference will be held immediately before the beginning of the expert evidence hearing on January 8, 2018.

[6] The oral submissions hearing will be held on **January 23 and 24, 2018**, in North Battleford, Saskatchewan. The Parties shall file their respective Memorandum of Fact and Law shortly after the expert evidence hearing and prior to the oral submissions hearing.

[7] The Parties shall make best efforts to provide the Tribunal with their respective reliance documents four to five days before the oral submissions hearing or on or before **January 17, 2018**. Otherwise, the Parties shall provide jointly or separately a status report on the reliance documents on or before **January 17, 2018**.

[8] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 19, 2017**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). If the Parties collectively agree that there is no particular need for the next CMC as the Claim is moving along accordingly or if a Party requires a CMC before October 19, 2017, they will advise the Registry.
