A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 17, 2019, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported the completion of the following steps towards a negotiated resolution of this Claim:

- a. In November 2018, the Parties met in the community to discuss the negotiation. At that time, evidence regarding a potential additional claim for loss of cattle, which was not pled in the original Declaration of Claim, was raised.
- b. On December 19, 2018, the Respondent shared its position on the claim for cattle loss. On December 21, 2018, the Respondent provided a global settlement proposal to the Claimant, which did not include the cattle allegations due to the current lack of details.
- c. The Claimant advised that it is actively considering the proposal and a counter-offer, and both Parties agreed that they are close to a resolution.

[2] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **February 28, 2019**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
