ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 12, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties have confirmed that they are prepared to go ahead with the expert evidence hearing scheduled for **February 5 to 7, 2018**.

[2] The Claimant expects to have two (2) or three (3) Elder or community witnesses for the oral history evidence hearing. The Claimant will advise the Tribunal and the Respondent on or before **December 22, 2017**, as to whether or not the Will-Say Statement can be completed within a timeframe reasonable to the Respondent in order to hold the oral history evidence hearing during the same week as the expert evidence hearing. If the Parties agree that the oral history evidence hearing can be held with the expert evidence hearing, the February 2018 hearing dates shall be extended by two days (February 8 to 9, 2018).

[3] The Parties shall file with the Tribunal their respective responding expert reports on or before **December 29, 2017**, and will advise whether reply expert reports are necessary on or before **January 4, 2018**.

[4] The Claimant shall provide the Respondent a draft Agreed Statement of Facts 30 days following the conclusion of the expert evidence hearing.

[5] The Parties continue to work towards preparing a Common Book of Documents which shall be filed with the Tribunal 30 days following the conclusion of the expert evidence hearing.

[6] The Tribunal shall issue the draft Bifurcation Order provided by the Claimant in its CMC Brief filed December 4, 2017, which is consented to by the Respondent.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **January 25, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
