A Case Management Conference was held by teleconference on November 14, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] Counsel for the Respondent indicated that the internal approvals necessary to move this matter into negotiations are pending final sign off. Once finalized, it is anticipated that the Respondent will formally acknowledge an outstanding lawful Treaty Land Entitlement

obligation to the Claimant, offer to negotiate a settlement, and invite the Claimant to apply for funding. The Respondent expects this to occur imminently.

[2] The Parties have indicated that they will then enter into a Negotiation Protocol for settlement of the Claim.

[3] The Parties shall file a joint application for a stay of proceedings with the Tribunal, in accordance with Practice Direction # 15, Stay of Proceedings, as soon after **February 15, 2019**, as their schedules will allow.
