A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 11, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent confirmed that its expert expects to have finished the Respondent's historical report by the end of September 2019.

[2] The Respondent reported that it no longer disputes and now agrees that the Tribunal has jurisdiction on allegations arising out of the Claimant's forensic accounting report. The Parties have agreed that the Claimant will amend its Declaration of Claim and the Respondent will amend its Response. Consequently, the Respondent expects that it will prepare an expert report that responds to the Claimant's forensic accounting report.

[3] The Claimant reported that it expects its expert report on loss of use to be completed and its settlement proposal to be tabled on or before **December 31, 2018**.

[4] The Respondent will require time to reflect on the settlement proposal. Consequently, the next CMC will be held by teleconference on **March 11, 2019**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
