A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 27, 2015, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Common Book of Documents shall contain all documents pertaining to this claim and to *Siska Indian Band v. HMQ*, SCT-7002-14 (“Siska Claim”). The Parties shall jointly report on the status of the Common Book of Documents before the next CMC on **June 30, 2015**.

[2] The Parties shall report on the status of the Agreed Statement of Facts before the next CMC on **June 30, 2015**.

[3] The Claimant shall provide Will-Says to the Respondent on or before **June 30, 2015**.

[4] Subject to decisions made at the next CMC, the Respondent will provide Will-Asks by **August 17, 2015**.

[5] The hearing on validity in this claim and in the Siska Claim is tentatively scheduled for **October 12 to 23, 2015**. The hearing will be held in the communities of the Claimant and the Siska Indian Band.

[6] The Claimant shall report to the Tribunal should there be any changes in its intention regarding additional expert reports on the width of right of way, keeping in mind the hearing schedule. .

[7] The next CMC will be held in person, jointly with the Siska Claim, on Tuesday, **June 30, 2015**, in Vancouver.
