**ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER**

**Honourable Paul Mayer**

**FURTHER** to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on December 5, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Claimant provided the Respondent with its expert survey report on April 24, 2018. The Respondent provided the Claimant with its responding expert report on June 29, 2018. The Claimant provided its reply expert report on August 14, 2018.

[2] The Respondent provided the Claimant with a third supplemental Affidavit of Documents on October 18, 2018. The Parties continue to collaborate on the Common Book of Documents.

[3] The Parties are working on a draft Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues.

[4] The Parties are committed to resolving the Claim through alternative dispute resolution. In pursuit of this goal they have held a useful, productive and substantive meeting on November 29, 2018. To allow time for the Respondent to review and evaluate the Claim, the Parties have requested a joint stay of proceedings until March 15, 2019. Should the Parties seek to extend the stay of proceedings after this time, they must file a Joint Application pursuant to Practice Direction # 15.

**THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:**

[5] A stay of proceedings is granted until March 15, 2019; and,

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **March 27, 2019**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
