ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Paul Mayer

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 7, 2016 at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation shall provide its proposed revisions/additions to the draft Agreed Statement of Facts to the Parties on or before **January 31,**

2017. The Parties expect that the Agreed Statement of Facts will be further amended following the completion of the oral history evidence hearing.

[2] The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation shall advise the Parties if further documents should be added to the common List of Documents on or before **January 31, 2017.**

[3] The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation shall provide its Will-Say statements to the Respondent one to two months prior to the oral history evidence hearing start date. The precise production date may be discussed and determined at the next CMC.

[4] The week of May 1, 2017 has been set aside for the oral history evidence hearing for Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation. The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation anticipates that four or five Elders will testify and that three days should be set aside for the hearing. The Tribunal advised the Claimant that a translator, if required, should be proposed to the Tribunal as soon as possible to allow time for necessary approval and retention by the Tribunal. The Claimant Iskatewizaagegan No. 39 Independent First Nation advised that it does not wish to call any further witnesses.

[5] The Respondent advised the Tribunal that the possibility for mediation on certain issues is still being considered by the Respondent but that no decision on the matter has been made.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **February 2, 2017,** at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
