A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person following the end of the expert evidence hearing in Fort Qu’Appelle on February 8, 2018, at 10:30 A.M., Central Time (Saskatchewan).

[1] The Claimant will meet with Elders to identify witnesses and their availability and will provide Will-Say Statements to the Respondent by March 26, 2018, in accordance with the Endorsement dated February 12, 2018.

[2] The Claimant will advise the Tribunal and the Respondent as soon possible if an oral history evidence hearing is unnecessary. An oral history hearing has been tentatively scheduled for June 19, 2018.

[3] The Claimant advised that it may be feasible to hold the hearing of oral submissions during the same week as the oral history evidence hearing.

[4] If an oral history evidence hearing occurs, the Respondent will advise soon after the hearing if it will continue litigating or if it will enter into negotiations or mediation. The Parties intend to discuss the possibilities and will advise the Tribunal of any development in the interim.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 10, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
