A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on February 11, 2019, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] On January 29, 2019, the Claimant received from the Respondent a second expert report dealing with disturbance related to the taking of the Forest Service Road. The Claimant anticipates that its expert will be able to review this report and the Respondent's expert

geotechnical report and expert land appraisal report by early April 2019. At that time, the Claimant will be able to assess options for possibly narrowing the issues or engaging in settlement discussions with the Respondent.

[2] At the next CMC, it is anticipated that the Parties will be able to indicate whether they consider that an expert evidence hearing will be necessary, and, if so, possible dates for the hearing.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 11, 2019**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
