A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 5, 2018, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant took the position that no further documents or research were required by its expert and that the Respondent’s expert should proceed with its responding report. The

Respondent observed that the evidentiary gaps identified by the Claimant's expert were worthy of follow-up and that it was trying to assist to that end in a collaborative way. However, the Respondent would direct its expert to proceed with its report. That expert cannot apparently devote full attention to the task until September 2018.
