ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Paul Mayer

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on August 4, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent indicated that at this time it is not ready to make any further admissions with respect to liability. The Respondent will report to the Tribunal on this issue on or before **September 28, 2017**.

[2] The Respondent indicated that with respect to an existing expert report on valuation, it may not be able to waive privilege due to issues with the terms of reference. Accordingly, the Respondent invites the Claimant to prepare its own expert report on valuation.

[3] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall discuss and attempt to determine whether the expert report on valuation will be a joint report or whether the Claimants will prepare a separate report, and the timelines for the required report. The Parties will provide an update on this issue at the next CMC.

[4] At the next CMC, the Claimant Iskatewizaagegan No. 39 Independent First Nation shall report on whether a second expert report, by an economist, will be necessary to address loss of economic opportunity or loss of use.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 18, 2017**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
