**ORDER**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

**UPON CONSIDERING THE REQUEST** of Counsel, filed January 30, 2015, with the Tribunal, for the Claimant to withdraw its opposition to the Respondent’s application that the “Kahkewistahaw First Nation 1907 Surrender Claim - Social Impact Assessment – February 2001” Report (the Report) prepared by Seven Oaks Consulting Inc. and Tim Holzkamm Consulting be deemed inadmissible as expert evidence in the hearing of the merits of this matter;

**THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS that:**

The Report is deemed not admissible as expert evidence upon consent of the Parties.

The Claimant shall provide the Tribunal with an anticipated deadline on the commission of the new report on the issue of Band funds for relief and support purposes as a replacement for Crown funding. Progress on the new report will be canvassed at the next Case Management Conference (CMC).

The next CMC is scheduled to be held by teleconference on April 22, 2015, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
