A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 27, 2015, at 2:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent indicated that there would be a change of counsel. The usual materials should be filed to indicate the change.

[2] The Parties agreed to the following filing schedule: (a) the Respondent shall file its Written Arguments and List of Authorities on or by **February 24, 2015** or two weeks after a decision on the Respondent's document application, whichever is later; and, (b) the Claimants shall file their Reply to the Respondent's Written Arguments and List of Authorities on or by **March 27, 2015** or 3.5 weeks after the Respondent files its Written Arguments, whichever is later.

[3] This schedule is subject to review at the instance of any Party depending on the result of an Application for Leave and Notice of Application to Have Documents Admitted Into Evidence that was heard immediately following the CMC.

[4] The validity hearing shall take place at the Doig River First Nation Administrative Complex commencing at 10:00 A.M. on **May 20, 21 and 22, 2015**.

[5] The Parties shall file a Joint Casebook on or by **April 27, 2015**.

[6] A Pre-Hearing Conference will be held by teleconference on **April 27, 2015**, at 12:30 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).
