A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 14, 2018, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The exchange of Part 2 of the Claimant’s expert report and the Respondent’s expert report shall be completed no later than **March 23, 2018**.

[2] On or before **May 16, 2018** the Parties shall report to the Tribunal in writing whether or not responsive reports will be required. If it is intended that there will be a responsive report from either Party or both, the Parties shall also indicate how long it is anticipated to take to obtain and deliver those reports.

[3] The Claimant will review the draft Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues and provide its comments to the Respondent on or before **March 23, 2018**. The Respondent shall report on whether it is satisfied with the Claimant's comments on or before **May 16, 2018**.

[4] The Claimant shall report on the following matters:

- Provide its proposed amendments to the Amended Declaration of Claim to the Respondent on or before **April 3, 2018**;
- Provide an updated list of documents for the Respondent's review on or before **April 13, 2018**; and,
- Report to the Tribunal in writing on whether or not it intends to bring forward oral history evidence on or before **May 16, 2018**.

[5] Each Party shall inform the Tribunal in writing of its view of the matters that are in issue on or before **May 16, 2018**.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **May 22, 2018**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
