ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 8, 2016, at 1:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimants indicated that they may need to amend their Declaration of Claim in respect of the relief claimed. The Respondent is agreeable, but only in respect of the relief claimed. Accordingly, if the Claimants determine that it is necessary to amend their Declaration of Claim they may do so, but only in respect of the relief claimed. Any such Amended Declaration of Claim shall be served and filed with the Tribunal on or before **June 30, 2016** and an Amended Response shall be filed with the Tribunal on or before **July 22, 2016**.

[2] The Parties agreed that in the interests of efficiency and economy the Compensation Phase should be heard in at least two sub-phases and the Tribunal agrees. The first sub-phase will be to determine how to calculate the historical loss. This being resolved the balance of the process to determine calculation will then be designed.

[3] The Parties are to have a proposal on proceeding to a hearing on how to calculate historical loss for consideration at the next CMC.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **August 29, 2016**, at 2:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).
