[1] The Tribunal is anticipating a Notice of Change of Counsel for the Claimant Montreal Lake Cree Nation.

[2] The Claimant Lac La Ronge Band and the Respondent agree that the first step is to have a hearing to answer the question on how much timber was removed preliminary to proceeding to a hearing at which the Parties would put forward their submissions on compensation.

[3] At the next CMC, the following items will be discussed:

- the Respondent will advise with respect to its retention of an expert witness on the volume of timber taken; and,
- review the direction that the Claim proceed first with a determination of the volume of timber taken in respect of which we will hear from newly appointed counsel for Montreal Lake Cree Nation.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 5, 2018**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
