A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14, 2019, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant confirmed that it held a ratification vote on April 3, 2019.

[2] The Claimant informed the Tribunal that one of the conditions precedent being requested by the Respondent is that a case filed before the Federal Court be dismissed.

[3] The Parties have agreed that it is not necessary to file the more complex motion for dismissal of a “representative proceeding” pursuant to rule 114 of the *Federal Courts Rules*, SOR/98-106.

[4] Instead, the Parties have agreed to apply for a dismissal order on consent from the Federal Court. The application has been prepared and it will be reviewed and signed by both Parties and then forwarded to the Federal Court.

[5] The Respondent indicated that it cannot predict how long it will take for the Minister to sign the settlement agreement. The Claimant wishes to clarify whether the Minister can sign it despite the pending Fall election.

[6] The next CMC will be held simultaneously with the next CMC in files SCT-3001-16 and SCT-3002-16, which is scheduled to be held by teleconference on **July 24, 2019**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
