RESPONSE TO LITTLE BLACK BEAR NATION APPLICATION**

The following is the response of the Claimant, Standing Buffalo Dakota First Nation [“Standing Buffalo”] response to the Application by Little Black Bear First Nation (“LBB”) to examine the Respondent for discovery concerning “Canada’s policy and rationale for setting aside fishing reserves in Treaty 4 territory.”

1. Standing Buffalo supports the application of LBB, however also acknowledges that the examination of a Crown witness based on the documentary record would be unlikely to assist in the determination of their interest in IR80A.
2. Standing Buffalo respectfully submits that in the event the application of LBB is granted, that leave be given to the parties to ask questions arising from the responses of the Respondent.
