A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 4, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The oral history evidence hearing for Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation will be held on **June 19 to 21, 2017**, in the Shoal Lake No. 40 community at a venue to be determined.

[2] The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation shall confirm as soon as possible with the Tribunal the number of witnesses it intends to call.

[3] The Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation shall prepare Will-Say Statements as soon as possible and shall produce them to the Respondent and Tribunal no later than on or before **June 5, 2017** (i.e. two weeks before the hearing starts).

[4] The Respondent did not have any further updates for the Claimants regarding the potential resolution of liability issues of the Claim, as raised at the previous CMC held on April 20, 2017. The Respondent is working on getting an update on this matter as soon as possible.

[5] The Claimant Iskatewizaagegan No. 39 First Nation shall let the Tribunal know whether or not it will attend this oral history evidence hearing of Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation, as soon as a decision is made in this regard.
