A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 24, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] Prior to the next CMC, the Respondent shall advise the Claimant and Tribunal in writing whether or not it will seek leave to file an Application to bifurcate the Claim into validity and compensation phases. The Claimant opposes bifurcation of the Claim in this fashion.

[2] The Parties have filed a Joint Proposed Plan of Proceeding dated January 18, 2017, which appears reasonable. The Parties agreed that a more complete and final Joint Plan of Proceeding depends in large part upon the determination of whether or not the Claim will be bifurcated.

[3] The Parties have agreed to a CMC being held approximately every 60 days as required or to reschedule or dispense with a CMC by joint notice to the Tribunal or at the Tribunal's direction.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 11, 2017**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
