A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 10, 2016, at 4:30 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent shall respond to the Claimant's proposal to streamline expert evidence for this Claim on or before **November 30, 2016**.

[2] The Respondent shall provide the Claimant with a draft Oral History Protocol on or before **December 30, 2016**.

[3] The Parties shall file an agreed plan of proceeding with the Tribunal on or before **January 5, 2017**.

[4] Prior to the next CMC, the Claimant shall provide to the Respondent any initial comments on the draft Oral History Protocol.

[5] The Claimant advised that an oral history evidence hearing could potentially be held in the spring or summer of 2017. The Tribunal proposed available dates in May and June of 2017, subject to remaining availability on a first-come, first-serve basis. Otherwise, dates in the remainder of summer and fall of 2017 may be considered.

[6] The Parties have agreed to reserve a determination on the issue of whether to bifurcate the Claim into separate validity and compensation phases for a later time.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **January 18, 2017**, at 3:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).
