**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Paul Mayer**

A first Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person in Fort Qu’Appelle on February 7, 2018, at 3:30 P.M., Central Time (Saskatchewan).

[1] The Parties advised that they will be seeking appraisal evidence early on in the proceedings.

[2] The Parties confirmed that a Notice pursuant to section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* is not required as a decision of the Tribunal in relation to this Claim is unlikely to significantly affect the interests of a province, First Nation or person.

[3] The Claimant indicated its interest in mediation of part or all of the issues as soon as it is practicable. As such, the Parties have discussed the possibility for mediation and hope to discuss it further once the expert reports are completed.

[4] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties will provide a Plan of Proceeding which will include the following:

- a. the filing dates for the Agreed Statement of Facts, Agreed Statement of Issues and Common Book of Documents;
- b. the date on which full disclosure and release of documents will be made;
- c. the name of experts and timelines for the completion of expert reports;
- d. the date(s) for the oral history evidence hearing and expert evidence hearing;
- e. the filing date for the Oral History Protocol; and,
- f. the date(s) for the oral submissions hearing as well as the filing dates for the Memoranda of Fact and Law.

[5] The Parties will consider the possibility of joint experts.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **May 18, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
