ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable Paul Mayer

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 18, 2017, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The last two weeks of June 2017 have been tentatively set aside for the oral history evidence hearing, which will be held in the community. Prior to the next CMC, the Claimant shall advise the Tribunal if any of these June dates may be confirmed for this hearing.

[2] The Parties and Tribunal agreed that an expert evidence hearing shall be held during the week of February 5-9, 2018. The Claimant shall advise at a later date if the expert evidence hearing will be held in the community or elsewhere.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **March 20, 2017**, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[4] **FURTHER** to the Parties' proposed Joint Plan of Proceeding dated January 5, 2017 ("Joint Plan of Proceeding"), **THE TRIBUNAL:**

a. Homologates the Joint Plan of Proceeding and orders the Parties to abide by it, subject to:

- i. the aforementioned endorsed potential change to the oral history evidence hearing being held sometime in the last two weeks of June 2017, rather than July of 2017, to be confirmed at the next CMC; and,
- ii. the expert evidence hearing dates being held in the week of February 5-9, 2018, rather than in the first week of February 2018.
