A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 17, 2015, at 2:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall establish a Common Book of Documents by **July 31, 2015**, subject to any further documents that either party may obtain in connection with any expert evidence on historical compensation.

[2] The Parties shall complete the Agreed Statement of Facts by **September 25, 2015**.

[3] The Claimant shall file its Memorandum of Fact and Law by **February 12, 2016**.

[4] The Respondent shall file its Memorandum of Fact and Law by **March 11, 2016**.

[5] The Claimant shall file its Reply by **March 24, 2016**.

[6] The week of April 4, 2016 is set aside for the liability phase hearing of the claim. The Parties will discuss between themselves the duration of the hearing and will inform the Tribunal accordingly. The Parties suggested that the hearing be held at the St. Eugene Golf Resort and Casino.

[7] The Parties have proposed that the next Case Management Conference take place after September 25, 2015. The Tribunal will contact the parties to discuss a specific date later this summer or at the beginning of September 2015.
