ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 29, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall deliver to the Respondent particulars of the acts on the part of the Crown that it alleges as a basis for its plea that the surrender of the Reserve was an exploitative bargain.

[2] The Respondent shall deliver to the Claimant particulars of the acts and omissions that it relies on in support of its plea of acquiescence and contributory negligence on the part of the Claimant.

[3] The Claimant shall compile a draft joint index of documents by **August 31, 2015**, and provide a copy to the Respondent and the Tribunal. This index shall specify on which list(s) the documents originally appeared.

[4] The Respondent shall provide the Claimant with any additional disclosure documents by **October 30, 2015**.

[5] The Parties shall work jointly towards the identification of subset of documents on which they will, respectively, rely at the hearing(s) (“reliance documents”).

[6] The Claimant anticipates providing an expert report concerning a survey of the subject lands to the Respondent and the Tribunal in the fall of 2015, and an expert report providing an appraisal of value by June 2016. Responsive reports shall be delivered with minimal delay after the receipt of the expert reports. Deadlines shall be set at the next CMC.

[7] The issue of bifurcation will be reconsidered after the expert reports on surveys are received.

[8] The Parties shall provide the Tribunal with dates for their availability for a CMC to be held in person, in Vancouver, at the end of September 2015.
