ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 20, 2015, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] A half day on April 11, 2015, shall be set aside for the *viva voce* testimony of Chief Mary Mahseelah and Tom Phillips.

[2] The Claimant shall provide a letter to the Respondent and the Tribunal on or before **October 28, 2015**, with respect to whether or not an interpreter will be required for the *viva voce* testimony of Chief Mary Mahseelah.

[3] The Claimant shall provide Will-Say statements on or before **November 14, 2015** and the Respondent shall provide Will-Ask statements on or before **December 18, 2015**.

[4] The Parties shall provide a Common List of Issues on or before **December 11, 2015**.

[5] The Claimant has provided 11 additional documents to the Respondent for inclusion in a Supplementary Book of Documents. The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with an explanation of the relevance of 10 of the documents on or before **October 23, 2015**.

[6] If necessary, the Claimant shall provide additional documents to the Respondent on or before **December 15, 2015**.

[7] The Respondent shall provide its expert report on or before **January 18, 2016**. If either Party wishes to file any additional documents after the Respondent's expert report is filed, it may do so by filing an application if agreement is not reached by both Parties.

[8] The hearing on the validity of the Claim is scheduled from April 11 to April 15, 2016, at the St. Eugene Golf Resort and Casino in British Columbia. There is interest in having the hearing held in the Claimant's community. The Parties shall discuss between themselves and report back to the Tribunal as soon as possible with respect to the date of the hearing and its location, including whether or not there should be separate hearing phases on the validity, i.e. one for the hearing of the witnesses and another for the oral submissions.
