A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 15, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant indicated that it has reviewed the Respondent's settlement offer and that it is not entirely satisfied with it. The Claimant is proposing a sit down meeting to discuss certain

topics not yet addressed in the Respondent's offer. The Respondent agrees with this suggestion and hopes that such a meeting can occur in the very near future. The Claimant also stated that if discussions with the Respondent were unsuccessful, the Claimant may request the Tribunal to mediate some points.

[2] The Claimant is seeking consent of the Province of Ontario to share information concerning the Ontario settlement agreement. The Claimant expects an answer from the Province of Ontario on or before May 31, 2018.

[3] The Respondent mentioned that if all of the relevant people are not able to coordinate their schedules to resolve matters on or before June 21, 2018 the Respondent will write a letter to the Tribunal disclosing why the Parties have not yet met, and when they will be able to meet. In that case the Tribunal will contact the Parties to reschedule the CMC.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **June 21, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
