A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 5, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they would undertake to make best efforts to finalize the Common Book of Documents, Agreed Statement of Issues and Agreed Statement of Facts on or

before **November, 15 2017**. The Parties shall file these three documents with the Tribunal if ready or else update the Tribunal in writing on when filing is to be expected.

[2] On or before **December 8, 2017**, the Parties shall inform the Tribunal in writing of potential oral argument hearing dates and the proposed timeline for the exchange of submissions. If an expert evidence hearing is required after all, the Parties shall propose their availability dates for an expert evidence hearing and oral argument hearing, along with a proposed filing schedule, and the Parties shall decide whether separate weeks for the hearings is necessary or not. The Claimant would like the hearing(s) to be held in the community.

[3] By letter dated September 14, 2017, the Respondent had advised the Tribunal and Claimant that the Respondent is not prepared to enter into mediation at this time and that the Parties should move forward with a hearing of the Claim. The Respondent confirmed that its position on this matter remains unchanged at this time.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **December 14, 2017**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
