ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person on February 13, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Parties shall advise the Tribunal of the anticipated date of completion of a Common Book of Documents on or before **March 3, 2015**. The Parties will work together to streamline the Common Book of Documents in this Claim and in *Siska Indian Band v Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada* (SCT-7002-14) (“*Siska*”).

[2] The Parties either together or separately shall advise the Tribunal on progress towards a Statement of Issues and the anticipated date of its finalization on or before **March 3, 2015**.

[3] The Claimant shall advise the Tribunal whether it will retain a surveyor expert and the anticipated timeline for the completion of an expert report on or before **March 3, 2015**.

[4] The evidentiary hearing tentatively booked for April 2015 is postponed.

[5] The Claimant shall provide will-says to the Respondent on or before **March 25, 2015**.

[6] The Claimant shall report to the Tribunal on the identification of oral history witnesses, including the number and names of such witnesses, and on whether it will retain an expert on the adequacy of compensation on or before **March 25, 2015**.

[7] The Parties shall report on the status of a protocol for oral history testimony, timelines for will-says and will-asks and potential dates for evidentiary hearings on or before **March 25, 2015**.

[8] The next CMC will be held in person, jointly with *Siska*, at the Canadian Industrial Relations Board, Vancouver, on Friday, **March 27, 2015, at 10:00 A.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver)**. CMC Briefs are not required for this CMC.
