A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 17, 2018, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties informed the Tribunal that they could not reach an agreement on selecting a joint survey expert and shall therefore proceed with separate survey expert reports.

[2] The Claimant's survey expert report shall be produced to the Respondent on or before **February 28, 2018**.

[3] Once the Claimant's expert survey report is produced, the Respondent will provide a responding expert report which is to be completed on or before **April 30, 2018**, on a best efforts basis. The Respondent will confirm with the Tribunal the timeframe for the completion of its responding survey expert report once it has engaged its expert.

[4] The Parties intend on finalizing the Common Book of Documents once the expert reports have been completed.

[5] The Parties will determine whether or not mediation is a possibility once the expert reports have been completed. If mediation is not a possibility, a hearing will be scheduled.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **May 17, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
