A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 5, 2017, at 1:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] A hearing of lay witnesses and experts will be held in Vancouver, British Columbia, commencing at 10:00 A.M. on **October 15, 2018** and continuing through to **October 19, 2018** as required.

[2] The Respondent reported that it had received particulars in respect of the initial Will-Say Statements provided by the Claimant. These particulars are satisfactory subject to one narrow point which the Respondent will shortly communicate to the Claimant. The Claimant indicated that it would take the request into consideration and respond accordingly. This matter will be reviewed at the next CMC.

[3] The Respondent confirmed that the Claimant had provided it with the Affidavit of a responsible representative of Meridian Forest Services Ltd. regarding calculation of the spatial data in the Claimant's expert report. The Respondent expressed satisfaction with the affidavit, which the Claimant's expert will embody into an addendum expert report.
