ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable William Grist

FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on March 6, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Parties remain open to trying to settle the Claim.

[2] The Tribunal expressed concern regarding the time already taken in this proceeding, as well as the need for proportionality and timely resolution. The Claimant would like to set a

hearing date. The Respondent expressed the view that expert evidence is required and also acknowledged the Tribunal's concern to set dates. After some discussion, the Respondent acknowledged and the Claimant agreed to the Tribunal's intention to truncate the prehearing schedule.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[3] The Respondent shall serve and file its expert report on or before **May 7, 2018**;

[4] The Claimant shall serve and file its reply expert report, if any, on or before **July 20, 2018**; and,

[5] The expert evidence hearing and oral submissions hearing on compensation shall take place in Vancouver sometime on or after August 7, 2018 for three consecutive days. The Parties shall file their written submissions with the Tribunal according to the following timeline:

- the Respondent shall serve and file its Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before **July 27, 2018**; and,
- the Claimant shall serve and file its Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before **August 3, 2018**.
