**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 7, 2016, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent reported that it had engaged a survey expert to complete a report in response to an issue raised by the Claimant in a Will-Say statement of proposed oral history evidence. The Respondent will produce and file with the Tribunal a copy of its expert's report on

or before **March 31, 2016**. The Claimant will determine whether it will retain a responding expert after it receives the Respondent's expert report.

[2] The Parties agreed that further document production might result from the Respondent's expert's report. They reported that they have been working co-operatively on the preparation of a Common Book of Documents, which is otherwise substantially complete. The Parties will complete the Common Book of Documents on or before **April 29, 2016** and file it with the Tribunal on or before **June 17, 2016**.

[3] The Parties reported that they are working co-operatively on the preparation of an Agreed Statement of Facts, which cannot probably be completed until the Respondent's expert survey report has been produced and the oral history testimony has been received. The Parties undertook to complete and file with the Tribunal an Agreed Statement of Facts on or before **August 26, 2016**.

[4] An oral history evidence hearing will be held to receive oral history testimony commencing on **July 12, 2016** at 10:00 A.M., in Tofino, British Columbia at a place to be arranged by the Registry and continuing on July 13 and 14, 2016.

[5] The hearing of the validity phase is scheduled to be held commencing on **October 5, 2016** in Tofino, British Columbia at a place to be arranged by the Registry and continuing on October 6, 2016.

[6] A Pre-Hearing Conference will be held by teleconference on **September 9, 2016** at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 11, 2016** at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
