APPLICABLE TO THIS CLAIM UNDER THE *SPECIFIC CLAIMS TRIBUNAL ACT***


Pursuant to Rule 29 of the *Specific Claims Rules of Practice and Procedure*, and the January 15, 2016 Endorsement of the Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson, this is an application by the Respondent for the determination of the compensation principles applicable to this Claim under the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* (Act).

This application is made on the following grounds:

1. Section 20 of the Act sets out the basis and limitations for decisions on compensation.
2. At the Case Management Conference held January 12, 2016, there was discussion about how to apply s. 20 to this Claim but no agreement was reached. The parties disagree specifically about how a claimant may pursue compensation.
3. A determination of the compensation principles applicable to this Claim is necessary to bring clarity and certainty to the process.
4. The Honourable Harry Slade granted leave to both parties to file a Notice of Application for the determination of the compensation principles applicable to this Claim under the Act.
