[1] The Respondent's Notice of Application for the Determination of the Compensation Principles Applicable to this Claim under the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act*, dated February 16, 2016, is hereby adjourned *sine die*, with liberty after the next CMC for the Respondent to request that the Application be brought forward for hearing.

[2] The Claimant shall instruct its expert(s) to proceed with the production of a report based on the compensation principles that, in their view, apply.

[3] The next CMC will take place a **week or two following the release of the decision in *Popkum First Nation v HMQ* (SCT-7005-11)**, in order to allow the Parties time to consider its application to the issues in this matter.

[4] The Claimant is directed to advise the Tribunal at the next CMC when they will be serving the Respondent and filing with the Tribunal their expert report.

[5] The setting of dates for the production of the Claimant's expert report(s); the Respondent's reply to the expert report(s), if applicable; the scheduling of a hearing; and, the delivery of the Parties Memorandum of Fact and Law, will be addressed during a CMC subsequent to the next scheduled CMC.
