**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 17, 2015, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent reported that it has one more batch of documents to produce. The documents are prepared independently by Library and Archives Canada, which has advised the

Respondent that a box will be arriving shortly. Once received, the Respondent will then have to scan the documents into the proper format for production to the Claimant.

[2] The Claimant indicated that the final batch of documents would be delivered to Joan Holmes & Associates for inclusion in the Categorization Report. It is expected that completion of the Report will then take about a month.

[3] The Respondent cannot determine whether it will require its own expert until it has had an opportunity to receive and review the Categorization Report. Progress on these questions will be reviewed at the next CMC.

[4] The Parties reported that they were working co-operatively on clarifying the bases for challenges or objections to items in the Categorization Report.

[5] Progress on the preparation of an Agreed Statement of Facts and a Common Book of Documents will be discussed at the next CMC.

[6] Timing and timelines in respect of a validity hearing will be considered at the next CMC.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference at a time and on a date during the weeks of April 4 or 11, 2016 to be coordinated by the Registry in consultation with the Parties.
