A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 3, 2018, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] A hearing on the Respondent’s Application for Bifurcation is set for April 27, 2018 in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

[2] The Respondent will read the Claimant's Responding Memorandum of Fact and Law on the Application for Bifurcation and thereafter indicate to the Claimant and the Tribunal in writing whether the April 27, 2018 hearing on the Application for Bifurcation will be necessary.

[3] An expert evidence hearing is scheduled for May 22-24, 2018 in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Should the Application for Bifurcation be dismissed by the Tribunal or withdrawn by the Respondent, the Respondent will write to the Tribunal to say if it can hire an expert to produce a report on historical loss in time for the scheduled expert evidence hearing.

[4] The Tribunal has requested the Claimant and the Respondent to discuss the possibility of examinations for discovery of the Manitoba Hydro witness or whether a subpoena is required.

[5] The next CMC shall be scheduled once the Respondent advises in writing whether the Application for Bifurcation hearing is necessary.
