A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 21, 2018, at 12:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant Iskatewizaagegan No. 39 Independent First Nation confirmed that the expert on valuation proposed by the Claimant Shoal Lake No. 40 First Nation will be an expert

on valuation for both Claimants and that it does not require a second economist report with respect to the loss of opportunity. The Claimants expect that the valuation expert report will be completed in August 2018.

[2] The Parties are exploring the potential for negotiating the Claim. The Claimants have instructions and have provided the Respondent with draft terms for negotiations. The Respondent is preparing a response.

[3] Counsel for the Respondent will inform the Registry if it receives instructions before April 20, 2018 from its client to enter into negotiations, so that an earlier date for the next CMC may be scheduled to discuss the possibility of a stay of proceedings.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **September 5, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
