A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 9, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent advised that it has still not received a mandate to negotiate the resolution of this Claim.

[2] The Parties advised that the Respondent has produced its expert report on historical loss for the Claimant's review; but that this report has not yet been filed with the Tribunal.

[3] The Parties will advise the Tribunal by way of a joint letter on or before **October 22, 2018** as to the estimated number of hours required for the examination and cross-examination of the anticipated expert witnesses, and the number of days required and proposed dates for the expert evidence hearing, to be held in early 2019.

[4] Within thirty (30) days, the Parties will advise the Tribunal by letter if they are officially entering negotiations and/or if tribunal-assisted mediation is desired. At this time, a CMC will be scheduled to either hear an application to stay the proceedings, or to discuss the expert evidence hearing schedule and any other issues related to the evidence.
