ENDORSEMENT

Honourable W.L. Whalen

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on August 31, 2016, at 3:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that delays in obtaining further information had delayed the preparation of an expert's report and that one of the Parties had retained another expert who would be delivering a report. Also, additional witnesses were being planned. As a result, the dates scheduled for the hearing of expert evidence from September 26 - 30, 2016, cannot proceed. The Parties anticipate that they would now require eight (8) days for the hearing of experts and related testimony.

[2] Therefore, on consent, the expert evidence hearing scheduled for September 26 - 30, 2016, is adjourned.

[3] The expert evidence hearing will be heard in Vancouver, British Columbia, from November 29 - December 2, 2016, and continuing from December 12 - 15, 2016. These dates may need to be revisited depending on the renewal of Justice Whalen's term as a Member of the Tribunal.
